
TROPICANA NORTH PROJECT

- Large gold deposits targeted




Tropicana – The Prize







- Anglogold Ashanti Australia 70% & Regis Resources Ltd 30%
- Tier 1 deposit: 7.9Moz Au³ (2012), FY2020 production 460,000oz⁴
- Discovered 2002-2005 by drilling a +3ppb Au soil anomaly⁵
- Individual shoots have <100m strike (>20 gram-metres)




Thunderstruck JV – Big Freeze



Big Freeze Discovery

- >900m long +1g/t Au anomaly in drill holes
- Quartz-sulphide veining associated with mineralisation
- Within a large, >2km long, +10ppb Au anomaly
- 500m from Atlantis, 8km from Hercules
- Follow-up 3,000m RC drill program commenced early Feb 2022

Advanced Gold Prospects

- Hercules: outstanding recent high-grade hits
- Atlantis: narrow shoots, bonanza gold grades, e.g.:
 - 15m @ 21.0 g/t Au from 50m (additional follow-up diamond drilling planned)

Mid-Stage Gold Prospects


- Big Freeze: >900m +1g/t Au
- Beanie: 1.5km from Hercules
 - +1g/t Au anomaly, single line, no nearby drilling
- Isolated +3g/t gold intervals in drilling along Hercules Shear Zone, e.g.:
 - 3m @ 11.8g/t Au from 47m (NL02669, north of Atlantis)
- RC and diamond drilling in parallel with Hercules program

Early-Stage Prospects

New structural/magnetic target zones defined from detailed aeromagnetic survey

Numerous drill hole gold anomalies within 1,900km² tenement holding






Carawine 100%




High Quality Ni-Cu Targets Identified

- Potential mafic-ultramafic intrusive complexes interpreted from geophysical and geochemical data
- "Nova" style magmatic Ni-Cu targeted
- Moving Loop EM planned H1 2022

Active Discovery Area

- Fertile magmatic Ni-Cu sulphide systems nearby
 - Galileo's Lantern prospect within 2km¹
 - Legend's Mawson discovery 50km to the northeast²
- Potential for palaeochannel and bedrock Au:
 - Rumble/IGO's Thunderstorm Au prospect,
 e.g. 16m @ 6.69g/t Au, 24km to the southeast³






